

Ground Zero Haitian Visit

On the 20th. March 2007 Ground Zero's CEO, Michael Barry, was invited by the Government of Canada to join a Commercial Delegation to examine as to how the company could integrate its Emergency Response System and Rural Access Network into Haiti.

Canada's investment in the renewal of infrastructure within Haiti has been fundamental in the restructuring of the country, and the Canadian delegation was given a very high priority by the Haitian Government.

Michael Barry met with seven ministers, the Prime Minister and the head of the Chamber of Commerce during the course of the visit, as well as representatives of Canadian Aid, The World Bank and USAid.
